







Objective

 To disseminate a broader understanding of health so that a social dimensions perspective becomes commonly used in analysis of problems in international health





Goal

To develop a high quality and practical social determinants of health 'lens' useable as a field tool by health activists in developing countries.







Activities

- PHM writes a project proposal (Hani,2mo)
- Present proposal to funding agencies (PHM)
- Advertise and employ a project coordinator (PHM)
- Develop an international SDH circle
- Advertise that PHM global is working on developing a SDH tool.

Project: Phase I (6 mo)

- Project coordinator +international circle researches and develops lens
- PHM global prints a brief summary with case studies
- PHM disseminates to grassroots that the tool exists and there is a resource person.



Project Phase III 3 mo

 Coordinator and international circle evaluate and redesign tool.

 The initial project output is thus a internationally field tested tool for social determinant of health analysis.

Phase II (15 mo)

- Coordinator works as a resource taking the tool to international situations and helping with its application.
- Coordinator simultaneously keeps a database of case studies.



Why?

- PHM becomes a grassroots resource and more a grassroots organization
- PHM builds its own organizational knowledge.
- PHM invests in widening a critically important alternative approach to health.
- Participatory research at its best!



From There....

- Coordinator (with PHM help) to try to present this participatory research to higher levels (e.g. WHO) and international conferences to disseminate SDH analysis.
- PHM to attempt to publicise the tool
 PHM global SDH specialist to be available to IPHU and other teaching institutions.
 PHM to consider using this approach
- PHM to consider using this approach (specialist employed plus international circle) to develop other core aspects of PHM analysis of health issues.

And then?

- ?continuing project- PHM to maintain an database and SDH as a resource person to assist grassroots activists.
- Next phase in participatory research: developing tools, knowledge and ideas in how to implement health from a SDH perspective...
